WHO WE ARE AND WHAT WE DO

The Dalgarno Safer Neighbourhoods Police Team is made up of Designated Ward Officers which consists of Police Constables and a Police Community Support Officers. We work closely with the council, community leaders and residents to identify policing priorities in the ward and implement tactics to combat issues which affect the community. The team conduct regular high visibility patrols across the Ward to deter and disrupt criminal activity and anti-social behaviour, paying particular attention to ASB hotspots. We also organise and attend a variety of community events, so if you have any events which you would like us to come to please get in touch!

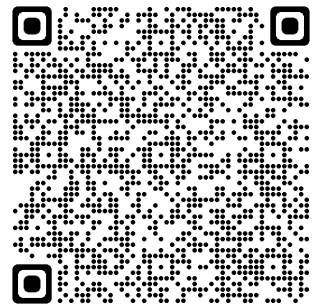
