HOSPITAL A&E CLOSURES

NHS North West London will start formal consultation on July 2nd

3 options

- Option A St Marys and C&W as 'major' hospitals.
 Hammersmith as 'specialist'. Charing Cross as 'local'
- Option B Charing Cross and St Mary's as 'major' with Hammersmith as 'specialist'
- Option C same as A but Ealing Hospital remains 'major'
 Option A is the 'preferred option' of the NHS
 Only 'major' hospitals will have an A&E department


Initial ideas for discussion at public meeting 30 June 2012

What is a Neighbourhood Forum?

- a new idea, introduced by the Localism Act 2011
- like a residents association, but with legal powers to draw up a Neighbourhood Plan
- a Forum can co-exist with existing groups and residents associations
- membership is open to anyone living or working in the Forum area
- a new committee, elected by all members

What is a Neighbourhood Plan?

- a plan for what local people want to see happen in their area
- when completed, becomes part of the planning framework, shaping development
- equivalent to the SPDs that the council prepares (e.g. for Westway, Latimer)
- requires 50% plus support from a local referendum, to be adopted
- might take 12-18 months to prepare



Potential local issues (1)

- keeping shopping parades and post office
- design of the east/west pedestrian/cycle link from Latimer Road to Wood Lane
- reviving Latimer Road as a mixed use employment/housing/creative quarter
- traffic in Wood Lane and North Pole Road
- ensuring Imperial West becomes part of the local community – and not separate

Potential local issues (2)

- updating conservation policies for the Oxford Gardens/St Quintins CA
- adding new conservation areas
- Thames Water plans to replace Counters
 Creek sewer and to prevent flooding
- eco-retrofitting and energy saving in homes
- Crossrail and HS2 proposals for Old Oak


The current proposal is for a St Quintin and Woodlands Neighbourhood Forum
