

Notes of decisions made at joint meeting of St Helen's Residents Association Committee and StQW Neighbourhood Forum Committee on 12 April 2023 at 95 Highlever Road, W10.

1. **St Helen's streetscape improvements.** Confirmed agreement that the Kelfield Gardens crossing of St Helen's Gardens is unclear and unsafe. Awaiting results of RBKC safety audit. SDiv to email St Helens Gardens Residents Association appropriately.
2. **Bid for City Living grant** for StQW awareness leaflet only successful at just over £900. MT/HP with assistance from SDuc to seek balance of original application from Dalgarno ward to enable later 'meet your neighbour' event to be held in forum consultation period..
3. **StQW/SHRA AGM and redesignation of StQW forum.** Favoured option 1 on paper tabled by HP. AGM date preferred 8 June at 7pm at St Helens church hall. HP to liaise with RBKC on start of forum consultation shortly thereafter. At AGM proposed changes to SHRA constitution to match boundaries and tweak to forum constitution to remove finance section agreed. HP and TM to design method for registering AGM attendees to ensure voting confined to residents living in area.
Leaflet about meeting to be delivered to all homes in area as far as possible by committee members (and people they can request to help) two weeks beforehand. Newsletter and other means to encourage support of forum redesignation by members once forum consultation has started.
4. **Planning application 3-5 Crowthorne Road.** To be item in newsletter asking for views on any problem or good scheme.
5. **Consultation on ebike parking bays.** Issue of loss of residents parking. Special newsletter to members to seek views.
6. **Latimer Road Unit 10 application.** 60 objections (including SHRA), 10 or less supporting.
7. **Ariadne public house.** Legal pack not yet available for auction, but agreed to challenge this if inaccurate. Allsops to be notified that we are likely to resist change of use.
8. **Nursery Lane.** Catherine Mannheim involved with Action Group.
9. **Kensal/Sainsburys development.** Ballymore held public meeting in Kensal Rise and likely to request meeting with SHRA.
