A reminder about neighbourhood plans


What is a Neighbourhood Plan?

- a plan for what local people want to see happen in their area
- when completed, becomes part of the council's planning framework, shaping development
- requires 50% plus support from a local referendum, to be adopted
- might take 12-18 months to prepare

- membership is open to anyone living or working in the Forum area
- 10 members of a new committee were elected at the last meeting
- 4 people have since said they would like to join the committee, and 1 has resigned.
